Cultists kill ex-Osun park revenue collector, burn corpse

FORMER Osun State park revenue collector, Waheed Abioye has been killed by suspected cultists who also burnt his body in a bush in Osogbo.

The Nation gathered that Waheed was abducted by cultists belonging to Aye confraternity on Tuesday and took him to an undisclosed location where they allegedly killed him.

It was learnt that Waheed, an ally to the chairman of National Union Road Transport Worker (NURTW), Kazeem Oyewale, a loyalist to the administration of Adegboyega Oyetola, was taken to the cultists' den and was tortured to death by cutting off his right leg.

The injury inflicted on him caused him to lose a lot of blood

which led to his death. The assailants of Waheed burnt his body before leaving the location.

Confirming the incident, the spokesperson of Osun Police Command, Yemisi Opalola said, its operatives received information that on 13th December 2022 at about 9:40 pm, some yet-to-be-identified men who were armed brought one man, later identified by his wife as Abioye Waheed to a refuse

dump site at Arikalamu area of Osogbo.

"Furthermore, Abioye Waheed was burnt to death beyond recognition by the unknown armed men who also cut off his right leg. The corpse has been removed by Olorunda by Olorunda LGA environmental agency to UNIOSUN Teaching Hospital Mortuary as further investigation is ongoing to arrest and prosecute the offenders."
