Three bodies recovered from Kirikiri canal

HREE bodies of two males and a female have been recovered in the three days from the Kirikiri canal, Apapa, Lagos.

Last year, over nine bloated bodies were found in the same

canal, some with injuries.

Though details of the circumstances that led to ugly sights could not be ascertained but residents within the Kirikiri area said the bodies could have been those of victims of robbers who were pushed into the canal from the Kirikiri, Mile-Two and Festacends for putting up resistance.

Others were of the view that

some of them could have been drunk and mistakenly plunged into the canalor robbers who were caught, beaten and thrown into the canal.

More worrisome is the fact that none of the corpses had been identified by residents on that axis.

Last Tuesday, members of staff of the Lagos State Ministry of Health/Occupational Health and Safety Services came in a whiteambulance to evacuate two bodies comprising of a male and a female.

Barely two days later, they returned to evacuate another bloated male body.
