ation Puff Adder II) to the area.

"In the hot engagement that ensued with the armed hood-lums, the professional team of policemen prevailed with their superior firepower, leading to the neutralisation of two of the bandits, recovery of one AK47 rifle, one motorcycle and a machete while the victims were rescued unhurt."
