

Osun is under Political Seige

Osun Presidential/NASS elections conducted under Siege Before the elections, Hon. Clement Olohunwa, who has now been declared member-elect for House of Representatives, Ila Federal Constituency was seen in a viral video inciting people to violence, saying: "Anywhere you go, you are the one to chase them, they must not chase you away."

"On yesterday's tribunal judgement, they must not jubilate anywhere, they must have no joy in their homes, no joy in their abode at all."

Because of that, "if they come out, chase them back inside"

Also, the member-elect for Ijesa-South, Hon. Sanya Omirin, said when he was fighting for others, he carried guns. For his own, he would use bomb and grenades.

All these are well documented because all the videos went viral.

And true to their threat, before, during and after the February 25 elections, our members were attacked, maimed, killed and in some instances chased out of their homes.

As at the last count, over 15 of them have been killed. However, because of the way they were killed, we shall reproduced just five of those incidents below.

But before then we must place on record that on the day of the presidential/NASS elections, political hoodlums loyal to the ruling PDP in the State, led by one notorious miscreant, Olalekan Ajagungbade popularly called "Emir" unleashed mayhem on the people of the State, particularly the APC members, who came out to exercise their civic duty. The hoodlums, who were large in number, also attacked the country home of the immediate past governor, Mr Adegboyega Oyetola, in Iragbiji where several polling units were raided as already thump-printed ballot boxes were carted away by the miscreants.

The political hoodlums armed with guns, cutlasses, axes and other dangerous weapons ransacked the strong holds of the opposition APC across the state.

Ilesa presented the worse scenerio, where Carlos Fadahunsi, a notorious PDP thug, who was initially arrested was hurriedly released a day to the elections and he was sighted brandishing guns all over Ilesa, dishing out orders to his gang members to attack APC members and voters. The last time he was arrested, the Police found guns and other dangerous weapons with him.

Carlos Fadahunsi was supported in the Ilesa axis by two other notorious thugs, who incidentally had been declared wanted by the Police, Solo Iwara and Bode Itaapa. The Police have not been able to rein them in because they get official protection from Governor Ademola Adeleke. For Ila Federal Constituency, Hon. Olohunwa, personally led the attacks on the APC members, drawing support from some thugs he imported from Ibadan, Oyo State.
