

② Ogboni leader dies tracking kidnappers of two wives

THE head of the Ogboni Aborigines, Oba Adetoyese Olakisan, was yesterday killed in a car crash while trailing the kidnappers of his two wives in Imesi-Ile in Obokun Local Government Area (LGA), Osun State.

Two others – a policeman and a family associate – also died in the lone accident.

The Nation gathered that gunmen stormed Olakisan's residence in the early hours of yesterday and abducted

both women.

Olakisan joined a rescue team to the Imesi-Ile/Ila Road area where they suspected the abductors were, but the vehicle conveying the team veered off the road and rammed into a tree, killing all three.

Osun-State Police Command spokesperson, Yemisi Opalola, confirmed the kidnap and the deaths.

"About the incident relat-

ed to Ogboni Agbaye. The man and a policeman who is the OC of Imesi-Ile were in a vehicle with one other woman. They were returning from a search for those that were kidnapped but had a lone accident. The vehicle veered off the road and rammed into a tree.

"They were all rushed to a hospital but they all died. The police are still inside the forest to rescue those that were kidnapped."
