Robbers kill man, cart away cash From Rasaq Ibrahim, Ado-Ekiti

N unnamed man was Thursday killed by suspected armed robbers who stole the over N10m he went to withdraw from a commercial bank in Ado-Ekiti, the Ekiti State capi-

It was gathered that the victim was on his way back from the bank when gunmen who trailed him, opened fire on him at the Irona area of the metropolis.

He died on spot.

The gunmen were said to have carried a sack suspected to be filled with money in the car and sped off the scene of incident.

According to eyewitness account, the gunmen, who wore black, waylaid the deceased's car, a Toyota Corolla, and shot at his windscreen before dragging him on floor.

The witness said they shot him four times on the chest.

He said the victim apparently knew he was being pursued as he tried to manoeuvre the roundabout hastily but was held down by traffic congestion.

When contacted, the spokesman for Ekiti State Police Command, Sunday Abutu, confirmed the incident, adding that inves-

tigation had commenced.
