

“Insecurity in Ekpeye communities have turned to usual church praises. When you talk of killings in Ekpeye both Ahoada East and Ahoada West.

“People no longer sleep in Ekpeye communities with their eyes closed. Everyday we record one killing or the other.

“April alone we counted at least 36 of such killings across the kingdom. There are six clans in Ekpeye Ethnic Nationality (kingdoms).

“Ubie clan recorded 16 murders to rank highest in last month’s incidents; Ahoada clan had six; Akoh counted three human losses, people’s properties were not spared either during some of these events,” he lamented.

He appealed to security agencies and political leaders to rise up to their statutory responsibilities of securing life and property in Ekpeye land and the state at large.

“I am calling on the DPO,the Area Commander,the JTF Commander and the two Local Government Chairmen of Ahoada East and Ahoada West and the Paramount rulers to come to the aide of poor masses in Ekpeye land before the thing turn to 2016 matter”
