

Togolese kills landlady in failed rape attempt

A 29-YEAR-OLD Togolese identified as Gbegele Mustapha has allegedly killed his landlady, Adijat Olaoye, 58, while attempting to rape her.

Gbegele was said to have stormed the deceased's room at Fanibi area of Akure, the state capital, to rape her.

It was gathered that the victim hit her head on the ground and her cries for help attracted neighbours who rescued her.

She died before she could be

rushed to the hospital.

The suspect said he was under the influence of Indian hemp when he attempted to commit the crime.

Also, a 27-year-old labourer, Mima Chinecherem, a native of Ebonyi State, was arrested for allegedly killing an 80-year-old grandmother, Madam Felicia Aderibigbe, at a farm in Odigbo Local Government Area.

They were among 18 sus-

pects arrested for various crimes.

Ondo Police spokesman, Funmi Odunlami-Omisanya, who spoke on behalf of the Commissioner, said seven suspected cultists were arrested in connection to recent cult killings in Owo, Owo local government.

"Late Mrs Aderibigbe Felicia aged 80 years left for farm on the 17th of May and did not return, all efforts to find her in the farm proved abortive until one Mima Chinecherem, 27, who specialises in Banga cutting at night, pegged a palm frond in front of the deceased's house.

This arose the suspicion of the woman's children, who apprehended the suspect and was immediately searched; the mobile phone of the old woman was recovered from him. He was handed over to the police and during interrogation, he claimed he saw the cutlass, bucket and mask at the boundary of the deceased's farm.
