

One dies, 10 injured in Niger road crash

ONE person has been killed and 10 others injured in a road crash along the Minna-Suleja road, Niger State.

The fatal crash which occurred over the weekend involved a white Pontiac vibe with registration number AA211SDA heading to Suleja from Minna and a green Toyota Carina E with registration number ABC44DX heading to Minna from Zaria.

The Niger State FRSC Sector Commander, Kumar Tsukwan, who confirmed the crash, said that the crash occurred as a result of a head-on collision of the two vehicles.

He said that the injured person is a female adult who resides in Minna while the injured persons include three men, six women, and a girl child.

He said that the injured victims were taken to IBB Special-

ist Hospital while the deceased was deposited in the mortuary of the IBB Specialist Hospital.

2 In Katsina State, gunmen killed a man, identified as Ibrahim Abdullahi in Kankia Local Government Area, the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) reports.

The man, popularly called Solo by locals, was killed around 8:40pm on Saturday, said spokesman for the Katsina State Police Command, ASP. Abubakar Aliyu, yesterday.

Aliyu said that the police command had commenced investigations into the killing.

Gunmen on motorcycles were said to have invaded a low-cost residential estate, near the Kankia General Hospital and shot Abdullahi who tried to question them.
