

Police kill two at hideouts' raid

The Police in [Adamawa State](#) have killed two suspected criminals in an operation that dislodged identified hideouts. The command said in a statement yesterday its operatives trailed and dislodged the suspected criminals in Yola South and Fufere local governments.

“The operation, which was carried out on September 11 followed the kidnap of Mrs Becky Ladawus, resident of Nyibango, Yola South Local Government,” the police said in the statement signed by spokesman, Suleiman Nguroje.

“More so, the operation, which was carried out by the operatives, led by Commander Crack Squad with hunters, yielded positive result as the victim was rescued unharmed,” the statement added.

It noted two of the suspected kidnappers, who laid ambush to prevent security agents’ access to their hideouts were killed.

“The outcome of these success followed a collaborative strategy designed by the command and hunters to rescue the kidnapped victim and arrest the culprits,” the police said.

It added two pump action guns, charms, chains and handsets were recovered, noting the commissioner of Police had ordered the fleeing suspects pursued.
