Six killed in security, IPOB/ESN

The Director of Army Public Relations, Brig.-Gen. Onyema Nwachukwu, who made this known in a statement, said the two incidents occurred yesterday.

He added: "Items recovered include one improvised 16 Multi Barrel Rocket Launcher (MBRL) gun mounted on a vehicle, one improvised 12 MBRL gun, one improvised 6 MBRL gun, one AK 47 rifle, one Dane gun, six locally-made rocket launchers, four Improvised Explosive Devices, five fragmental jackets, one Baofeng radio, military camouflage uniforms and assorted charms."
