

Air Force kills eight terrorists in Borno

An airstrike by the [Nigerian Air Force](#) (NAF) component of Operation Hakin Kai, a military operation against Boko Haram and other groups in North East Nigeria, has killed eight terrorists.

The terrorists were killed yesterday when NAF aircraft on an armed reconnaissance mission took out a gun truck at Baranga village in Marte Local Government of Borno State, NAF's spokesperson, Air Commodore Edward Gabkwet, said in a statement yesterday.

Edward said: "The opportunity strike, which presented itself unexpectedly, occurred when two armed terrorists on a motorcycle along an active track were trailed."

"After sighting the aircraft, the terrorists took cover under thick vegetation. Upon engaging the vegetation cover, a gun truck with eight terrorists suddenly appeared, speeding off to evade the attack. Subsequently, the gun truck was engaged and destroyed, thus eliminating the terrorists."

The spokesperson said, though remnants of terrorists in North East Nigeria have continued to seek the covers of thick forests and vegetation to evade being detected by security forces, the Wednesday airstrike was "a clear indication of the commitment of the
