Court remands fake doctor over alleged murder of patient

N Iyaganku Magistrates' Court, has remanded a 45-year-old fake doctor, Adegoke Olaoluwa, for allegedly causing the death of his patient.

The Magistrate, Mrs A.T. Oyediji, who did not take the defendant's plea, ordered that he be remanded in Agodi correctional facility in Ibadan, pending legal advice from the Office of Oyo State Directorate of

Public Prosecution (DPP). The News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) reports that Olaoluwa, of Idi-Aro area of Ibadan, is facing a count charge of murder.

Earlier, the Police Prosecutor, Insp Opeyemi Olagunju, told the court that the defendant had, on Feb. 20, at about 10.00 a.m., at Mercy Clinic and Maternity, Idi-Aro, Ibadan, caused the death of one Adekunle Badmus, 45, unlawfully.

Olagunju said that the

defendant administered saline drugs on the patient without lawful justification.

The offence, according to the prosecutor, is contrary to Section 316 and punishable under Sections 319 and 484 of the Criminal Code, Laws of Oyo State, 2000.

Section 484 stipulates three years imprisonment for an offender, while Section 319 prescribes death

sentence.
