Death toll in Bauchi alms stampede hits seven

EATH toll in the stampede at a Zakaat event in Bauchi State has increased to seven.

A stampede occurred about 10am at the Shafa Holdings Company Plc headquarters on Jos Road, on Sunday, during the distribution of the Zakaat items, distributed by a Bauchi-based philanthropist.

The distribution was said to have begun smoothly with beneficiaries, mostly women, called in groups to receive items, until restlessness among others led to a

struggle to gain access to the premises.

Police spokesperson Ahmed Wakili, who gave an update of the situation, said two more women died at the Tafawa Balewa University Teaching Hospital (ATBUTH) hospital, while the third woman died at home.

They are Aisha Usman (13); Sahura Abubakar (55); Aisha Ibrahim Abubakar (43) and Khadija Isah (8); Maryam Suleiman (20); Maryam Shuibu (16) and Hassana Saidu (53).

65-year-old ex-convict arrested with drugs
