dead in Enugu

Hoodlums at the weekend attacked a Police Station at Umuabor Eha-Alumona in Nsukka Local Government Area of Enugu State leaving two policemen dead.

The hoodlums had earlier on Saturday evening attacked Police and Road Safety teams at nearby Orba community in Udenu Local Government Area of the state and reportedly left three policemen and one officer of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) dead.

Our correspondent learnt that the attack on Umuabor Eha-Alumona Police Station took place around 10 pm on Saturday.

It was further gathered that the earlier attack in the nearby Orba was targeted at the popular traditional ruler of Egali Amalla Community in Udeni Local Area, Igwe Patrick Eze, popularly known as Igwe Waziri, who escaped.

The Enugu State Police Command's spokesperson, DSP Daniel Ndukwe, did not answer calls nor respond to the message sent to him for a confirmation of the said attacks.

Before the Saturday incidents, the gunmen had in the previous night attacked a police checkpoint along Presidential Road, Enugu metropolis, killing two police officers, an incident that forced the Governor, Peter Mbah, to place a N10 million bounty on the killers, suspected to be the armed members of the IPOB/ESN criminal elements, who operated in three SUV jeeps.

It could be recalled that penultimate weekend, two policemen and three vigilante operatives otherwise known as Neighbourhood Watch Group, were killed after an attack on them by a gang of rampaging hoodlums in Igga community in Uzo-Uwani local government area of Enugu State.
