

Two remanded for alleged murder, damage, threat to life in Igboho

A CHIEF Magistrate Court in Ibadan has remanded two suspects in Agodi Correction Centre for the alleged murder of two persons in Igboho town, Oorelope Local Government Area, Oyo State.

The suspects, Kareem Tajudeen Baale and Ismail Jamiu, were arraigned on a three-count charge - and murder, damage and threat to life and assault.

The suspects were alleged

to have conspired and killed an old man, Mr Oyedokun Jimoh and Wasiu Jimoh, on their farmland in Odoowo Village, Igboho, Oorelope Local Government Area of Oyo State.

However, they pleaded not guilty to the charges.

The Chief Magistrate, O. O. Ogunkanmi, ordered them to be remanded at the Correctional Centre for alleged murder, while granting them bail for the other two charges.
