

Five hunters nabbed for allegedly killing teenager over N20,000 theft accusation



Five hunters in **Adamawa State** have been arrested by the police for allegedly killing a teenage boy over alleged theft of N20,000.

The five, the Adamawa State Police Command said in a statement yesterday, tortured the 14-year-old teenager in Maiha Local Government Area until he died.

The statement, released by the police image maker in the state, SP Suleiman Nguroje, said the suspects carried out the fatal torture on suspicion that he stole the said N20,000.

It added that the five were arrested on Wednesday, June 5 “for the unlawful arrest and torture” of the teenager.

“The suspects are currently under investigation and will be charged to court for the law to take its course,” the statement said.

It quoted the state Commissioner of Police, CP Dakonmbo Morris, as condemning the actions of the hunters and warning members of the public against taking the law into their own hands.
