Troops repel attack on Kaduna community, neutralise two terrorists

ROOPS of the Nigerian Army on Operation Forest Sanity have thwarted a terrorists' attack on Saulawa community in Birnin Gwari Local Government Area of Kaduna State and eliminated two terrorists.

According to the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN), the Army, in a post on its official X Handle yesterday, said the success was recorded on Friday.

It said the troops, on a fighting patrol to Saulawa, cleared Maidaro and Ngade Alha villages before making contact with the rampaging

terrorists.

It added that one AK-47 rifle, one AK-47 rifle magazine leaded with 23 rounds of 7.62mm special ammunition, and 11 motorcycles, were recovered during the operation.

"The troops in their untiring commitment have continued to deny the terrorists freedom of action and significantly undermined their capabilities.

"The Nigerian Army remains determined to protect the nation and its citizens from the scourge of terrorism," it said.
