Man dies observing 19-days fasting

in Lagos State has confirmed the death of a 58-year old unnamed man while embarking on a spiritual fasting.

The command's spokesperson, Benjamin Hundeyin, a Superintendent of Police, confirmed this to the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) yesterday

in Lagos.

Hundeyin said the incident happened in Alagbado axis of the state about 600 am on Monday. He said the deceased's younger brother, whose name was not also mentioned, reported the incident at the Alagbado Police Division about 7pm same day. According to him, the younger brother said his brother died while allegedly undergoing 19 days of dry fasting.

Hundeyin said: "No foul play suspected, family demands to convey the body for burial."
