

Four killed, 20 injured in Osun multiple auto crash

NO fewer than four travelers died while 20 others sustained various degrees of injuries in a multiple accident that occurred in Osun State.

The Nation gathered that the accident occurred at Ikeji-Arakeji along Osun/Ondo Road in Ori-Ade Local Government Area of Osun State.

A viral video obtained by *The Nation* revealed that three vehicles including two buses and one truck

were involved in the multiple crashes.

One of the buses caught fire as passengers including two corps members were seen lying down on the floor. Residents and commuters around the area were wailing.

Confirming the incident, the Osun State Commandant of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC), Taofeek Sokunbi, blamed

the accident on over-speeding and careless driving.

He said: "The accident occurred three days ago. Four people died and 20 people were injured. The accident occurred where there was a speed breaker.

"I want to urge drivers to drive carefully on the road because the accident was caused by over-speeding and carelessness on the path of the driver."
