## Three passengers die in Lagos tanker crash



Three people died yesterday when a tanker carrying black oil suffered a brake failure, leading to a fatal multivehicle crash at Second Rainbow, inward Mile 2 on the Oshodi-Apapa Expressway.

The tanker, which lost control, rammed into two Volkswagen commercial buses and a Honda car with the registration number KTU 223 GH at about 6pm.

The impact resulted in the deaths of three passengers aboard one of the Volkswagen buses.
