Death toll in Jigawa tanker explosion hits 166




NSIB probes accident

Death toll in the **Jigawa State** tanker explosion has risen to 166 as of yesterday, with many still hospitalised.

The Nigerian Safety Investigation Bureau (NSIB) has launched an investigation into the accident which happened at Majia town, Taura Local Government Area.

In a statement, the NSIB Director of Public Affairs and Family Assistance, Mrs. Bimbo Oladeji, said the bureau is 'aware of the tragic petrol tanker explosion'.

According to Mrs. Oladeji, the NSIB has deployed experts to probe the accident.
The statement reads: "We extend our heartfelt condolences to the families affected by this devastating accident. The NSIB is committed to uncovering the cause of the explosion and ensuring that safety lessons are learned.
"Further updates on the investigation would be communicated as the NSIB team gathers and analyses evidence from the scene."
