Police foil banditry attacks, rescue six kidnapped victims in Katsina



The **Katsina State Police Command** has successfully thwarted a banditry attack and rescued kidnap victims in the Unguwar Batsaka area of Jibia township.

In a statement released by ASP Abubakar Sadiq Aliyu, the Police Public Relations Officer for Katsina State, it was reported that a distress call was received at the Jibia Divisional Police Headquarters regarding a group of armed bandits attacking Unguwar Batsaka.

The assailants were reportedly armed with dangerous weapons and firing indiscriminately while attempting to abduct residents.


He said: "Swiftly, the DPO Jibia mobilised a team of operatives in collaboration with the military, members of the Katsina State Community Watch Corps (KSCWC), and vigilantes to the scene, where they engaged the bandits in a fierce gun duel that lasted about an hour, forcing the bandits to flee the scene with various degrees of bullet injuries.


