Native doctor, client nabbed for burying man alive



THE police have arrested a native doctor and his client in Ugbaike community Enugu Ezike, in Igboeze North Local Government Area of Enugu State, for allegedly burying a young man identified as Chikwado Eze alive, leading to his death. The men include Chikwado's father, Uwakwe Eze and the native doctor simply identified as

From Damian Duruiheoma, Enugu Onuwa.

The incident, it was gathered, was meant to fortify the deceased for his future business endeavours abroad.

Sources from the community said Chikwado had recently secured a visa to travel abroad for greener pastures, but his father insisted that a spiritual fortification was necessary to guarantee his success overseas.

The father reportedly took him to a native doctor, who recommended an unusual ritual meant to bury the young man alive for 90 minutes, with the assurance that this act would grant him access to success and remove any danger in his way abroad.
