

Suspected cultists kill groom-to-be in Edo



Gunmen suspected to be cultists have killed a man whose wedding was scheduled for December in Edo.

The victim, simply identified as Danladi, was reportedly killed at a friend's shop located about 100 metres from the Esigie Police Division in **Oredo Local Government Area**, one of the municipal council areas in the state.

A source, who pleaded anonymity, noted that Danladi was sitting in the shop when the gun emerged from a GLK Benz jeep and shot him twice at close range.

“Danladi is an easy going guy. He was the son of Seriki Hausa in the area. His death has created a huge vacuum in his family and a painful loss to his would-be wife.
