Mother seeks justice over toddler's death



A distraught mother has taken to social media to demand justice over the death of her toddler in a Lagos school.

The woman, Ella, through her X account @AbiaPrincess, alleged that her two-year-old went to school on January 15 but didn't return home alive.

Calling on the **Lagos State Government** and the police to investigate circumstances surrounding her child's death, the woman said the school, located at Sangotedo, told them the toddler drowned in the pool.

She alleged that their investigation showed the child was electrocuted, adding that the school made it look as though it was a case of drowning.

The woman wondered how the child was able to get to the pool which had barricades, asking how a toddler was able to climb the fence.
