Bello Turji's camp in disarray after troops kill deputy, brother



Troops of Operation Fansan Yamma have neutralised the second-in-command of notorious terrorist leader **Bello Turji's**, Aminu Kanawa.

The troops also inflicted injuries on some of Turji's closest allies, who include his younger brother, Dosso and Danbokolo, an associate.

The Army Director Defence Media Operation, Maj.-Gen. Edward Buba, said the troops neutralised several key commanders of Bello Turji. They included Abu Dan Shehu, Jabbi Dogo, Dan Kane, Basiru Yellow, Kabiru Gebe, Bello Buba and Dan Inna, and Kahon-Saniya-Yafi-Bahaushe.

In all, Gen. Buba further said, the troops neutralised over 24 fleeing terrorists from Turji's camp around Gebe and Isa Local Government Area of Sokoto State, as well as around Gidan Rijiya in Shinkafi Local Government Area of Zamfara State.

The troops also neutralised another notable terrorists' kingpin identified as Suleiman a loyalist of late notorious terrorist leader, Halilu Sububu, during the encounter with Turji's enclaves around Fakai high ground.

Gen. Buba said the late Suleiman was leading a reinforcement team to rescue Turji's camp when he was hit during the fire-fight.

The Army described the death of Turji's men as a big blow to the terrorist network in the Northwest.

Gen. Buba reiterated the commitment of the troops in eliminating terrorists and that they would not relent on their efforts until they achieved their mission.

"The troops' operations are aimed at creating an atmosphere of safety and security for all citizens, Gen. Buba said.
