

Man 'kills' wife after dispute in Lagos



Lagos State Police have arrested Peter Dike for allegedly stabbing his wife to death during a dispute at their apartment in Oke Ira Ilogbo Eremi community, Morogbo.

The incident occurred on Wednesday, when an argument between Dike and his 38-year-old wife escalated into an altercation.

In the heat of the fight, Dike reportedly rushed into the kitchen, grabbed a knife, and stabbed his wife in several parts of her body.

According to eyewitnesses, the woman was left in a pool of blood, writhing in pains before dying.

Dike allegedly remained beside his wife's body until the police arrived.

The state Police Public Relations Officer, Benjamin Hundeyin, said: "The case is confirmed. After a team of detectives in the area got the information, they swiftly moved in and arrested the suspect. One kitchen knife stained with blood was recovered from him. He confessed to the crime."

The victim's remains were evacuated and deposited at the General Hospital morgue in Badagry.
