Two killed as land grabbers clash in Osun



No fewer than two persons were yesterday reportedly killed as two groups of land grabbers clashed.

The land grabbers clashed at Latona as a group led by a popular political thug arrived to collect money from a developer of a property.

However, another group resisted the group, saying that they were in charge of the area, the reason they came to collect the tip from the developer.

A source said "The boys were angry because they were resisted. They told the Latona boys that their boss is the number one in **Osun State** and his action must not be impeded by anyone.
