NAF airstrikes foil Sallah day terror attack on Borno



The **Nigerian Air Force (NAF)** said yesterday that its fighter aircraft had decimated key Boko Haram hideouts at Tumbumma Baba and Chiralia in the Southern Tumbuns, Borno State.

NAF's Director of Information, Air Commodore Ehimen Ejodame, said the feat was achieved in a series of precision airstrikes conducted under the auspices of Operation Hadin Kai on June 5 and 6.
