ble started in Ulakwo when a youth suspected to be drunk, snatched a bottle from the table and stabbed another youth in the course of an argument during the burial rites of a deceased colleague.

The injured boy was reportedly rushed to the hospital for treatment but he gave up the ghost. His furious friends stormed Ulakwo 2 on a reprisal mission.

It was gathered that the

armed youths, who stormed the community with guns, shot one person, identified as Oyedikachi dead, burnt a house and also raided the town.

Oyedikachi, a Chemistry graduate, was said to have just left the university.

Reports said security personnel have taken over the enter community to ensure that there was no further breakdown of law and order.
