Osawe said the accident involved an 18 seater bus and one articulated lorry when they had an head-on

He stated that the 18 seater bus was carrying 16 passengers including a conductor when the accident occurred at about 1.00 p.m. in the afternoon.

He further mentioned that 15 passengers lost their lives on the spot of the accident. Giving the break down number of people involved, he said out of the number, eleven women and three men lost their lives and that the only surviving victim is already at the University of Ilorin teaching

hospital receiving treatment.

He explained that the bus and the articulate lorry crashed due to dangerous overtaken and over-speeding. New Nigerian further gathered that the passengers of the bus mostly women were travelling to Jebba to buy bush meat to

Mr. Osawe further disclosed that corpses of the 15 passengers have been deposited at the mortuary of the University of Ilorin Teaching hospital in Ilorin.
