It was gathered that deliberations are on at the high command of the force on when Aregbesola will be moved to Osun State, where the incident actually occurred, for prosecution.

Our correspondent also gathered that the Lagos home of the gubernatorial aspirant has been subjected to search by the police shortly after his arrest.

Meanwhile, the Yoruba socio-cultural group, Afenifere and the political campaign organization of Engr. Aregbesola Oranmiya have condemned in strong terms the arrest by the police.

They however called for the immediate release of the commissioner, while urging the police to fish out those who are behind the bloody violent attacks.
