

Storey building collapses in Port Harcourt ...kills one

ONE person is feared dead and three others seriously wounded when another storey building collapsed in Port Harcourt at about 2 pm on Tuesday.

The building, which is under construction, belongs to a commercial bank at Benjamin Opara Street, by Olu Obasanjo Road, Port Harcourt.

An eyewitness said the building collapsed about

three months after the construction work started.

Some masons were plastering the walls of the building when the incident occurred, thus bringing the number of collapsed buildings in Port Harcourt to three in recent time.

New Nigerian learnt that officials of the National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) carried out rescue operation at the scene and took the wounded to an unknown hospital for treatment
