National Hospital calls for removal of body of crash victim

THE National Hospital, Abuja, has given a three-month grace for identification and collection of the corpse of one of the victims of the ill-fated ADC plane crash.

The hospital's Assistant Information Services, Mr. Sadiq Yahaya said at the weekend in Abuja that the hospital would be compelled to bury the corpse if it was not claimed.

Yahaya said 21 corpses were brought to the hospi-

tal following the October 29, plane crash at the Nnamdi Azikiwe International Airport, Abuja.

For Governor Ibrahim Idris of Kogi State, it was a happy day as he saw his daughter walk for the first time after her admission following the plane crash.

Idris, whose three daughters survived the crash was on hand to see the Uthman Dan Fodio University, Sokoto student walk.

Yahaya said the girl had

been in the intensive care unit of the hospital since the crash which claimed 106 persons.

He said the governor expressed joy when he visited the hospital's Chief Medical Director, Dr. Olusegun Ajuwon, adding that the girl demanded to eat a meal prepared by her father.

Yahaya said three survivors of the crash were still recuperating in the hospital, adding that "they are improving".
