POLICE ARREST MAN WITH 3 HUMAN HEADS

New Nigerian gathered that one of the heads was seen with its two eyes widely opened an indication, that the victim was recently killed.

It was further gathered that Mr. Somorin before his arrest took a motor bike (Okada) and allegedly offered the Okada operator a blood stained money which drew the curiosity of the Okada man.

The bike man was said to have alerted the Odua People's Congress, haven

confirmed to have seen fresh human head in a black polythene bag before the policemen were called upon to effect his arrest.

Making a confessional statement after a thorough search of his residence where three fresh human heads were found, Somorin said that he had succeeded in disposing off four human heads before he ran out of luck.

He said too, that a woman Mrs. Sogbae, a trader at Itoku market is a

contact person who purchases human heads.

According to him, the woman had earlier purchased four goods (human heads) sometimes last year and again demanded for another supply which he (Somorin) attempted to supply before he was arrested by policemen.

As of the time *New Ni-*

gerian visited Ita-baale in Ijeun-titun the house where the herbalist lives was already set ablaze by irate mob, not minding that the herbalist was a tenant.

Confirming the arrest, the Police Public Relation Officer (PPRO) Mr. Femi Awoyale said the two of them (Somorin and

Sogbae) are now giving useful information while he urged members of the public to cooperate with the police.

Awoyale however condemned the burning of the house by the irate mob saying, "That is not the solution to the problem and that such an act would hinder investigation as many facts/evidences could have been found in the house if not burnt.
