

Driver of exploded tanker died —FRSC

THE driver of the tanker which exploded late Monday night along the Lagos/Ibadan Expressway was burnt beyond recognition, the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN), has confirmed.

The Mowe Unit Commander of the FRSC, M R . U a k h e m e n Ojeamiren, confirmed the accident which occurred near the Mountain of Fire and Miracle

Ministries.

Ojeamiren, an Asst. Corps Commander, said that the tanker, with Reg. No. LAGOS: XB 310 GGE, which was heading to Ibadan from Lagos fell and immediately caught fire.

He said that the tanker also rammed into a trailer with Reg. No. LAGOS: XL 849 MUS, loaded with cotton wool on the other side

of the road.

Ojeamiren said that everything on the trailer was completely burnt.

"The vehicles had been removed from the road and the remains of the tanker driver handed over to the police," he said.

Ojeamiren added that the police claimed they were interested in the incident since it might involve litigation.
