

Man with lady's head arrested in Ibadan

A MIDDLE aged man simply identified as Tiamiyu was arrested on Easter Sunday at Molete area of Ibadan, the Oyo State capital with a fresh head of a young lady.

New Nigerian gathered that nemesis caught up with the middle aged man now in police net when he was about boarding a commercial bus at Molete to Oja-Oba/Mapo area of the town.

It was learnt that the man said to have arrived the Molete over head bridge area of Ibadan at about 1:45 p.m. neatly packed the fresh human head in a black polythene bag stuffed with cotton wool.

Eye witness accounts said trouble started for the man when he waited for over 15

minutes without seeing any of the commercial buses plying the area and became worried on noticing that some of the traders under the Molete over head bridge had focused attention on him.

New Nigerian learnt that one of the traders in the area noticed that there were traces of blood coming out of the nylon bag the middle aged man was carrying and called the attention of other traders to her discovery.

However, New Nigerian gathered that while the traders were making the move, a commercial bus heading towards Agodi Gate area of Ibadan arrived and the man was said to have rushed into the bus in order to escape possible arrest the traders.

Sensing that the man was

about to escape through the commercial bus, the traders and others at the bus stop ordered him out of the bus and asked him to offload the contents of the nylon bag in his hand.

According to the eye witnesses, the middle aged man was surrounded by the traders and other passers by as well as area boys from the adjoining areas.

During the search conducted on the man, the fresh head of a lady was discovered in the nylon with him with blood said to be oozing out of the lady's neck.

Tiamiyu was immediately handed over to the police with the fresh human head and was subsequently moved to the Orita Challenge Police Station for further interrogations.

Speaking with New Nigerian, Oyo State Police Public Relations Officer, ASP Bisi Okuwobi confirmed the arrest of the middle aged man and that he has been helping the police in their investigations.

ASP Okuwobi however said the head discovered from the man was not a fresh one, saying, "No, it is not true that it is a fresh human head. But it is true that a woman's head was found in his possession in a polythene bag. And the man when we interrogated him was behaving like a mad man."
