Kano MP dies in inferno

THE ancient city of Kano was last Thursday thrown into sadness with the reported death

of a member of the state House of Assembly, Alhaji Mukhtar Liman Rogo (ANPP), who sus-

tained severe burns from a burning generator. The deceased, Alhaji Mukhtar Liman Rogo, aged 43

was confirmed to have caught fire in his residence at Farawa House of Assembly quarters in Kano while trying to refill an

engine generator. It was confimed that the generator exploded in ball of fire and trapped the late Mukhtar

Rogo that subsequently left him with severe burns in most parts of his body.

Alhaji Mukhtar Rogo was

at the initial stage admitted at the Aminy Kanb Teaching Hospital where he started recovering but suddenly gave up

the ghost. Late Mukhtar Rogo who was serving his first terture at the House of Assembly is sur-

vived by two wives and 10 children. He has since been buried in his country home Rogo.

The acting Governor of the Engineer Tijjani state. Muhammad Gwarzo led a state Government delegation to the

deceased home town where

they attended the funeral prayer and brayed for the repose of the departing MP. Engineer Tijjani Gwearzo described the late Lawmaker as

a promising politician who died at a time his services were needed most by the entire people of Kano and prayed unto Attal to grant the bereaved the

fortitude to bear the loss. The Speaker of the Assembly, Alhaji Abdul Azeez Garba Gafasa, also described the late colleague as a "complete gen-

tleman" that approached lawmaking process with "ease and precision," saying the deceased died when his services were so much needed.
