

Police exhume body of woman allegedly killed by son

THE police in Asaba has exhumed the body of a woman, Henrietta Omoriegie, who was allegedly killed and buried by her son.

A police source told the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) yesterday in Asaba that the body of the woman was buried on the Asaba-Benin expressway near the Asaba refuse dump site.

The police Spokesman in Delta, Mr. Charles Muka, confirmed the incident in Asaba.

Muka said that the woman was declared missing on February 9, adding that her son allegedly abducted her and took her away in her Toyota Camry with registration Number BK600 FKY.

He also said that the son and his three friends were later arrested at a private university in Delta, where the car and her Sony Eriksson GSM handset were recovered.

He further said that a purse containing an Oceanic Bank and Zenith Bank ATM cards, property of the woman, were also recovered.

Muka said that police investigation revealed that the woman had been killed and buried at the time she was declared missing.

He said that the law would take its course on the matter.
