

4 boys found dead in car

RESIDENTS of Sabon Layi
quarters in Jalingo, the

Taraba State capital, are in
mourning mood following the
discovery of dead bodies of four
boys in a Honda Accord (2002

model) car in the area.

The car belonging to a
businessman Bukar Abacha was
found with the dead bodies of

the boys who disappeared
previous day.

New Nigerian learnt that
was a friend of the owner of the
car who wanted to use the car
to convey a sick person to the
hospital that discovered the
dead bodies when he opened
one of the doors of the car.

It was further learnt that the
friend of the owner of the car
raised alarm when he discovered
the bodies of the boys which
attracted a large crowd.

Fathers of the dead boys told
newsmen that their children
disappeared the previous day
and they reported the matter to

the Tudun Wada Police outpost while a search continued throughout the day without trace.

The Police Public Relations Officer in the Taraba Police Command ASP Sani Basan Inna confirmed that four dead bodies of boys was discovered in a Honda Accord car belonging to a businessman Bukar Abacha.

He said the police are now investigating circumstances leading to the death of the boys who are between the ages of four and seven.

ASP Sani Basan Inna said the bodies of the late boys were taken to Specialist Hospital Jalingo for post mortem.

However the corpse of the boys were released at about 6pm by the hospital authorities to their parents for burial.

The names of the boys are Abubakar Nasir; seven years, Sani Salihu; five years, Khalid Abba; four years and Mujahid Alhaji; three years.
