sources, one Kazeem Bello was said to have allegedly led some members of Eliye Cult from Akala area to launch an attack on some boys at Kayode street, where messrs Shina Ajah, Sule Abibu, Akeem Bashiru and a yet to be identified person sustained serious injuries.

Following the high degree of the injury, Shina Ajah and the yet to be identified person were later confirmed dead, while others are still receiving treatment at an undisclosed hospital where they were rushed to.

Though, the root cause of the clash could not be ascertained as at the time of filing the report, but the source was of the opinion that it may not be unconnected with an on-going leadership tussle between the groups.

The police public relations officer, Lagos command, Mr. Frank Mba confirmed the incident in a bulletin made available to journalists in his office., but was however silence on whether an arrest has been made or not.

According to him, policemen from the State Criminal Department (CIB), Yaba who visited the scene have removed the corpse to public mortuary while investigation into the case has commenced.
