members that their candidate would emerge the winner at the end of the day led to the death of one person and others being injured in Rigasa, a suburb of Kaduna metropolis.

New Nigerian on Sunday gathered that the incident occurred when the CPC supporters took to the major streets in the area to jubilate the victory of their candidate even when declaration of election results was being expected.

The incident which took place at Zaria Road, a

street in the area, was said to have occurred when, a golf car purported to be one of those jubilating, lost control as a result of brake failure ran over a gutter to hit electric pole, killing one person and injuring 15 others.

According to an eye witness, "We were at home when we heard that CPC had won. We rushed out and in the process, some people brought out their motorcycles and cars to jubilate. The golf driver lost control and crossed over a gutter to hit electric pole close to where we were

jubilating.

"So it was the broken block from the gutter that hit Abdulsalam. The other people have since been rushed to the hospital for immediate treatment, because they were also hit by the sign board the car smashed," he said.

Meanwhile when our reporter visited the hospital where one of the victims was admitted he was said to have been discharged just as the rest only sustained minor injuries.

However, the body of the deceased has since been buried according to Islamic rites.
