## 3 remanded over death of constable

AN Ebute Meta Chief Magistrates' Court, Lagos on Monday remanded three men in prison custody for allegedly stabbing a police officer to death.

SeyiEgbonwan, 30, Wale Ojupon, 18, and Daniel Emeka. 18, are facing a seven-count charge of stealing, breach of peace, murder, assault, and possession of firearms before Mrs Oyindamola Ogala, a Chief Magistrate.

Ogalasaid the plea of the accused persons could not be taken because the court had no jurisdiction in a murder case.

She ordered that they be kept in custody pending when the court would get advice from the Director of Public Prosecutions.

The prosecutor, ASP Eshiet Eshiet, told the court that the accused conspired, kidnapped and killed one police constable, Abimbola Adesoji, by stabbing him with a knife.
