Two dead, one injured in auto crash on Okene-Lokoja-Abuja highway

TWO persons lost their lives while one other person was seriously injured on Sunday in an auto crash at Abobo village along the Okene-Lokoja-Abuja highway

The crash according to an eyewitness involved a **Honda Accord** with registration number AW

94 KTN, a truck with registration number NSR 120 YQ and a **Mercedes Benz** truck with registration BMA 291 XA respectively.

The accident he disclosed occurred around 10.00p.m in the night, when one of the truck heading towards Abuja drove dangerously and in the process collided with two other vehicles coming from the opposite direction, killing two per-

sons instantly and injured one other person.

The Federal Road safety Commission (FRSC) rescue team came immediately and rescued the victims, clearing the obstruction caused by the accident.

The Kogi State Sector Commander, Olakunle Motajo, who confirmed the accident, blamed it on dangerous driving on the part of the drivers, saying that

the dead had been taken to the morgue while the injured one has been taken to the hospital for treatment.

He however warned motorists to desist from dangerous driving and to obey speed limit as well as avoid night journey, saying that if this is adhered to, accident on the road would be reduced to the barest minimum.
