

Police rescue 2 kidnapped Chinese nationals in Ogun

TWO Chinese nationals who were kidnapped at Odogunyan community have been rescued by the Ogun State police command, just as one of the kidnappers was killed

during exchange of gun fire.

The Chinese, whose names were given as Song Ji-ang She and Zhang Wen Xue, were rescued unhurt.

Other members of the kidnapped gang reportedly escaped with bullet wounds,

while their operational vehicle, a BMW car with registration number CK 737 LSD, was also recovered.

Nigerian Tribune reliably gathered that the Assistant Inspector General of Zone 2, Mamman Tsafe,

called the Ogun Commissioner of Police, Ikemefuna Okoye, at about 3.00 p.m to inform him of the kidnap.

The divisional police officer of Ogijo division, Toyin Afolagun, reportedly pursued the kidnappers after sighting them in their operational vehicle.

They were said to have gone into a house at Shotunbo, Kilometre 3, off Sagamu, Ikorodu road.

Confirming the incident, the state Police Public Relations Officer, Muyiwa Adejobi, said the police commissioner, who visited the scene, had ordered that the area be cordoned off and placed under surveillance.

He added that the case had been transferred to the State Criminal Investigation Department, Eleweran, for further investigation.
