Car crushes 3 persons to death in Nasarawa

THREE persons, among who were two boys of the same mother, were on Saturday night, crushed to death by a *Toyota Camry* car with plate number Lagos Festac 931AR, on Lafia-Jos road in Lafia Local Government Area of Nasarawa State.

Eyewitnesses told the Nigerian Tribune that the
incident happened directly
opposite Investment House
at Bukan-Sidi, around 8.35
p.m. It was further gathered
that the car, which was driven by a drunk driver, suddenly veered off its lane and
ran into pedestrians at the
other side of the road, kill-

ing three and injuring one.

learnt that the victims had been evacuated from the scene of the accident by a good Samaritan to Dahaltu Araf Specialist Hospital before the arrival of officials of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC).

did not want his name in print told Nigerian Tribune that, "we were all at stadium junction beer spot enjoying ourselves when he told us that he was going home. He stays in town, not around that area, so I don't really know what brought him to Bukan-Sidi again."

The driver has since been arrested and detained at Lafia Police Area Command, Ombi one.
