Police kill 4 robbery suspects in Ogun

THE Special Anti-Robbery
Squad of the Ogun State
police command, last
Tuesday, killed four armed
robbers in their hideout at
Odan Abuja village, Igbesa, in Ado-Odo/Ota Local
Government Area.

This was disclosed by the command's Public Relations Officer, Olumuyiwa Adejobi, to the Nigerian Tribune on Thursday in Abeokuta.

Adejobi, a Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP), said that the robbery suspects were part of the gang that attacked officials of the Vigilance Services of Ogun State, at Onihale axis in Ifo area of the state.

According to him, the same robbery gang also killed one of the serving officers of SARS sometimes ago.

The PPRO said that the Officer-in-Charge of SARS, SUPOL Ahmed Tijani, led a team of policemen to the spot where the criminals were hiding, and engaged them in a fierce gun battle which led to the killing of four of them.
