UNILAG lecturer shot dead

MOYOSORE SOLARIN - LAGOS

A lecturer at the University of Lagos (UNILAG), Mr Cyril Ikemefuna, was shot by unknown gunmen in his house on Wednesday and has been reported dead.

The Dean of the Faculty in which the deceased lectured, Industrial Relations and Personnel Management, Professor Rasheed Ojikutu,

who confirmed the incident, said Ikemefuna was shot in his house located at Akoka, Lagos, in the early hours of Wednesday, September 18.

He said according to the accounts of the deceased's son, he was at the gate on his way out early in the morning when robbers invaded the house, during which his father was shot in the stomach and was

rushed to the hospital.

Ojikutu said as soon as the school got wind of the incident, a call was put through by the university to the Lagos State Teaching Hospital (LUTH) Chief Medical Director, after which Ikemefuna had to be moved to a private ward, as he could not be attended to because of the ongoing strike by government

health workers.

"After waiting for some time on the hospital premises, we were eventually briefed by the doctors on the eventual death of CY (as he was fondly called), at about 12.00.p.m," the dean said.

The deceased, aged 57, was said to have joined the UNILAG work force in 1997.
