Unknown gunmen kill lecturer in Kano

UNKNOWN gunmen, on Wednesday night, killed a lecturer of the Department of Chemistry (name withheld) at the Federal College of Education, Kano.

According to a source who preferred anonymity, the lecturer was shot five times in his uncompleted building at a ring road in the outskirts of Kano metropolis.

The source hinted that the lecturer moved into his uncompleted apartment some months ago.

It was further gathered that none of his property was taken away by the assailants.

When the Nigerian Tribune visited the FCE, Kano, students as well as lecturers were seen discussing the issue.

However, all efforts to get the comment of the police on the killing proved abortive as the image maker of the state police command was absent when the Nigerian Tribune visited his office.

But a source within the police command, who pleaded not to have his name in print, confirmed the incident.

The lecturer's body has since been taken to Gumel, his hometown for burial in accordance to Islamic rites.
